1. This table reflects investment allocations for activities primarily undertaken in 2023/24, and includes a portion of investment paid in June 2022. The expenditure profile of a High Performance Program can vary significantly from year to year of an Olympic/Paralympic cycle. It is the expectation of the ASC that the sport manages the funding provided annually to support activities to enable the implementation of their four year High Performance Plan.
 2. High Performance includes High Performance, Athlete Wellbeing & Engagement, Performance Pathways, Equipment Funding, Mental Performance in Competition, National Generation 2032 Coach Program, and other high performance one-off initiatives.
 3. Other Funding includes Women Leaders in Sport, Coach Experiential Learning Program, Preventative Health Initiatives, Legacy Projects and other one-off initiatives.
- * Combat Institute High Performance funding includes funding for Boxing, Judo and Taekwondo.
