

AUSBIKE INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

Cost: \$150

The AusBike Instructor training will introduce you to worldwide recognised best bike education Instructor practices.

The course is aimed at club and community members, parents and teachers who want to help build and develop beginner level bike riders (aged 5 -12) to improve their bike riding skills.

Course content includes:

- Managing group and individual behaviours
- Risk management
- Core4Skills™ fundamental skill development
- Basic bike and helmet setup

At the completion of the course, AusBike Instructors will be able to deliver AusBike sessions in a controlled environment (eg school grounds, open space such as an oval, netball/basketball court, indoor venue and bike paths).

AusBike Instructor Training pre-requisites:

- Minimum age 16 years
- Current AusCycling membership
- Working with Children check
- First Aid Certificate, Provide First Aid - HLTAID011 or higher

The AusBike Instructor course is a combination of theory, online modules and the submission of a video assessment to be reviewed by AusCycling. To be accredited, you must:

- Complete all online modules
- Submit video assessment
- Meet the pre-requisite requirements listed above
